




1837

In September 1837, the Indian chief of the Sauk KEOKUK decided to bury the hatchet by offering to the peoples of Europe that they smoke the peace pipe together.

Because of this act of peace and in honor of the Indian chief, the town of KEOKUK was founded at the same time on the Mississippi River in Iowa.

Mr. Jewett Fulton, from Keokuk, Iowa - on the Mississippi, west of Chicago, - set out in December 1931 to send a message by letter to all non-English-speaking Rotary Clubs outside the United States, urging a worldwide symbolical smoking of the peace pipe.







The Tallinn, Estonia Tragedy.





